Please read carefully:

- THEME for artwork should fall into the following categories: Agriculture, Community or Dayton History.
- Each piece of art should incorporate a chicken or chickens in some fashion. It can be a small portion of your art work or the whole thing.
- Completed canvas boards should be returned to the DCDA Program Artscape Coordinator Jenni Middleton. Call 971 264-4289 when ready.
- Canvases no larger than 24" H x 24" W can be used. You can use wood block or water color paper as well. Canvases will be provided by the DCDA at no charge to the Artist.
- If you would like to use another type of medium, you must have it approved ahead of time.
- Use your choice of paint (product must be dry when turned in)
- Do not cut or make holes in the canvas board.
- To avoid damage to your art piece, keep the board in a safe place.
- Dayton Artscape is not a forum for religious or political statement.
- Dayton Artscape banners and art pieces will be displayed in public and should be appropriate for all ages to view
- All artwork created become the sole property of the Dayton Community
 Development Association and use of said art will be at the discretion of the
 Dayton Community Development Association
